


Community Groups

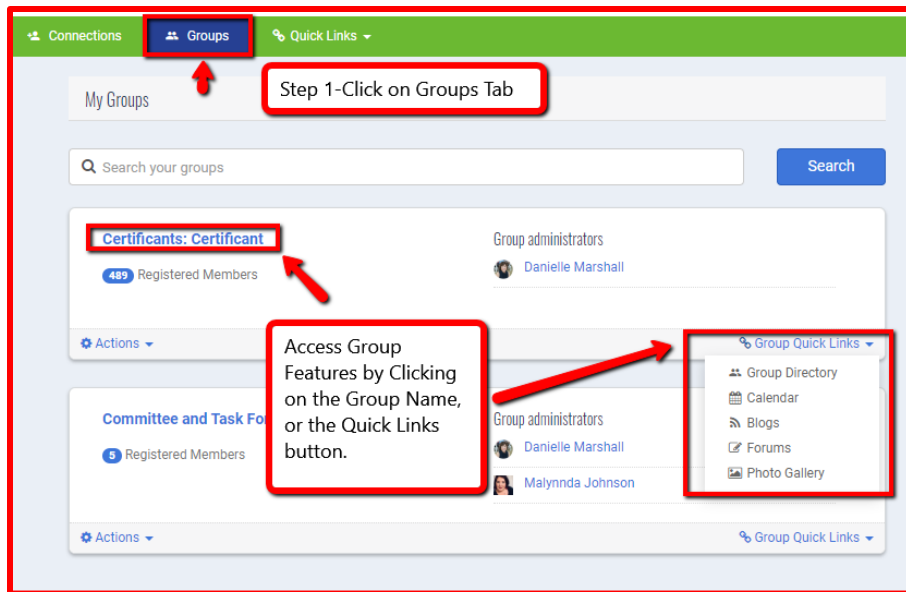

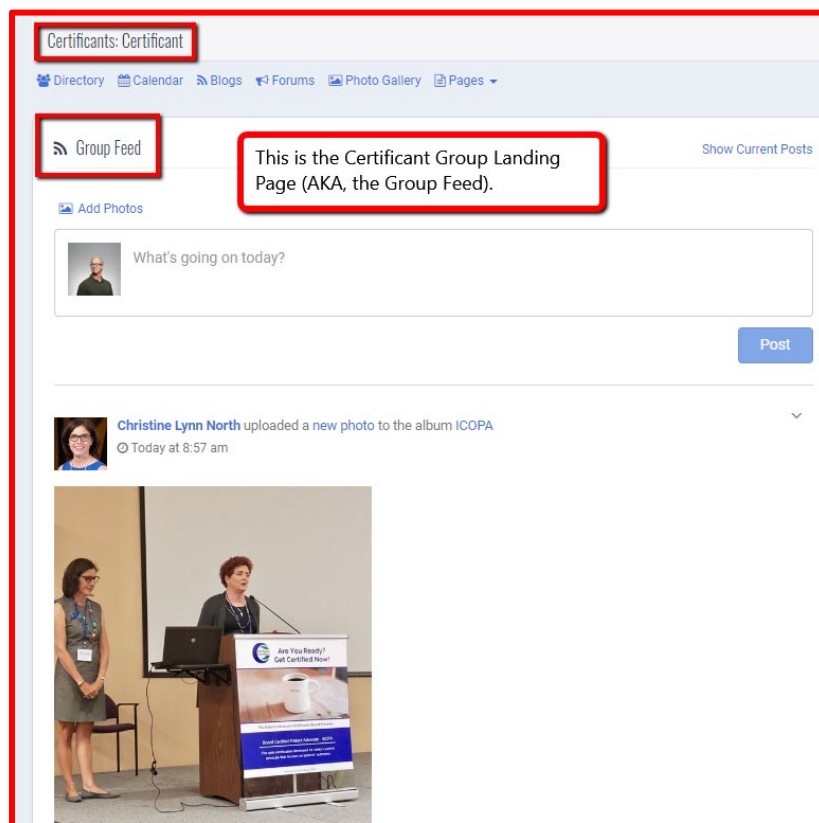

Group Quick Links

To access the group features, click on the Group Quick Links button in the bottom right corner or by clicking on the name of the group. (see image below).



Each Group opens to Landing page called the Group Feed similar to that of other social media platforms.



Description of Group Features:

Directory – a listing of all the individuals enrolled in the Group. For the Certificant Group, that includes all individuals who have earned the BCPA credential.

Calendar – A listing of key dates and/or events. Recent and upcoming BCPA Pre-Approved CE Events are currently listed.

Blogs – are informational entries posted by your group moderator. Members can comment on blog posts and may also subscribe to receive blog updates.

Forums – are threaded discussion topics. Group members may add new topics and comment on topics posted by others.

Photo Gallery – offers a place to share images with other members of the group.

Pages – Shared files are located in the Pages tab (see image below).
